## OUR WEBSITE

This Cookie Policy is issued on behalf of Bento Nouveau Inc. Bento Nouveau Inc. is part of the Snowfox Group so when we mention "we", "us" or "our" in this policy, we are referring to the relevant company in the Snowfox Group responsible for processing your data. Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website, and it also allows us to improve our site.

This Cookie Policy only relates to your use of our website to browse and view our products.

Throughout our website we may link to other websites owned and operated by certain trusted third parties to make additional products and services available to you. These other third-party websites may also use cookies or similar technologies in accordance with their own separate policies. For privacy information relating to these other third-party websites, please consult their policies as appropriate.

## WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. They save and retrieve pieces of information about your visit to the website – for example, how you entered the site, how you navigated through the site and what information and documentation was of interest to you. This means that when you go back to a website, it can often give you tailored options based on the information it has stored about you on your last visit. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

There are three main types of cookies:

- **Session cookies:** specific to a particular visit and limited to sending session identifiers (random numbers generated by the server) so you don't have to re-enter information when you navigate to a new page or check out. Session cookies are not permanently stored on your device and are deleted when the browser closes;
- **Persistent cookies:** record information about your preferences and are stored in your browser cache or mobile device; and
- **Third party cookies:** placed by someone other than us which may gather data across multiple websites or sessions. Cookies set by us are called first party cookies.

We describe our use of cookies, including a detailed list of your information which we and others may collect through cookies, below.

<b>Performance/Statistics cookies</b> – helps website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously
